



## Anne Geleta

Anne Geleta, 92, passed away quietly in the early hours of July 31, 2025. Anne was born in 1933 in Cohoes, NY to the late John and Anna (Haleczko) Geleta. The youngest of six children, she grew up in Cohoes and graduated from Cohoes High School in 1950. For most of her life she was a communicant of the St. Nicholas Orthodox Church in Cohoes while also attending the Nativity of the Most Holy Mother of God church in Albany, NY for the last several years. Anne's Orthodox faith was an important facet of her long life.

Anne enjoyed talking to friends, family, and generally anyone who would listen, and she could likely find a new friend anywhere she went. Through deeply ingrained beliefs about almost every topic, she would debate on the news of yesterday, today, and tomorrow at the spur of the moment. Private by nature, she chose a solitary path and remained deeply committed to the routines and habits that gave her comfort.

Anne was generous and always fiercely certain and consistent. She worked for many years at the New York State Department of Labor and retired to a life filled with bargain hunting, storytelling, and many afternoons of daytime soap operas. Her sharp and focused memory, present up until the end, was an endless source of genealogical knowledge and family history concentrated

around her deep Eastern European roots.

Predeceased by her five siblings—John Geleta, William Geleta, Antoinette Fialka, Pauline Hohn, and Peter Geleta—she is survived by an extended family of nieces, nephews, and their children who knew her as she was: uncompromising, proud, and uniquely herself.
