Earl C. Hebert, 80, passed away unexpectedly on December 18, 2025. Born and raised in Cohoes, Earl was the son of the late Clarence Earl Hebert and June Beatrice Taylor Hebert, and the devoted husband of the late Estelle Hebert for over 50 years.

Earl attended school in the Cohoes School District and worked for 30 years at the Ford Motor Company in Green Island. He proudly served his country during the Vietnam War as a member of the U.S. Army from 1963 to 1966.

A lifelong volunteer, Earl served as a Cub Scout Leader, Boy Scout Leader, and was a member of the Governor Clinton Council from 1969 to 2008. In 1983, he received the Silver Beaver Award, the highest honor bestowed upon an adult leader by the Boy Scouts of America.

Earl was a dedicated member of the Loyal Order of Moose since 1970, holding numerous leadership positions, including Lodge-level roles, District State President, Moose International Legion Ambassador, and concluding his Moose career with a five-year term as Moose International Family Activities Coordinator.

He was inducted into the Cohoes Hall of Fame in 2002 and received the

Colonel Robert Cramer Service Medal in 2016 for his extensive community service, which included fostering, volunteering, and active involvement with organizations such as the Loyal Order of Moose, Cohoes/Waterford Elks, and the Cohoes American Legion.

Earl is survived by his daughters, Tina (Michael) Christie and Lisa Hebert (Mark) Ryan; his siblings, Gary (Mary) Hebert, Penny (the late Peter) Reynolds, Jack Hebert, and Frank (Linda) Townsend; six grandchildren, Jennifer (Dave) Coghill, Jessica (Jeff) Zovistoski, Zachary Schongar, Sean Ryan, Matthew Christie, and Meaghan Christie; and three great-grandchildren, Zoey Coghill, Cody Coghill, and Evelyn Zovistoski. He was predeceased by siblings Thomas Hebert, Wayne Hebert, Gail Hebert, and Pamela Hebert.
