On Saturday, June 5th, Frank Marro, loving husband, father, and WWII Navy Combat Veteran, passed away at age 94. Frank was born in Troy, NY. At age 16, he joined the Navy in 1944 and served aboard the USS Butte (Attack Class Transport) and the USS Lexington (Essex Class Carrier). As a Naval Coxswain, he piloted LCVP landing craft in the south pacific areas of the Philippines, Okinawa, Saipan, and Ulithi, as well as Korea and China. He was honorably discharged from the Navy in 1946.

Frank received his accounting degree from the University of Michigan. He worked for 8 years with the Army Audit Agency stationed in France traveling throughout Europe. Returning to the US, he practiced accounting and finance in the Troy/Schenectady/Cohoes area for over 45 years.

Frank had a passion for skiing and golf, which he continued to enjoy well into his 80's. As a hobby he loved to watch classic movies from the 40's and 50's. He was affectionately known as "Uncle Murph" to many of his nephews and nieces. Everyone loved his quick wit and sense of humor.

Frank is survived by his daughter, Marie Cichy and her husband, Fran; his son, Frank Marro and his wife, Malanei and their families which include 9 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren. Additionally, a devoted niece, Candy Kufel, her husband, Mike and son, Scott, who greatly assisted Frank in

his later years.

A funeral mass will be held at 10 am on Wednesday, June 9th at Sacred Heart Church in Cicero, NY. Then, on Thursday, June 10th there will be a military burial ceremony at the Saratoga National Cemetery in Schuylerville, NY.
