Michael G. LaBombard, 62, passed away on Tuesday, January 12, 2021. Born in Troy, N.Y., son of Dorothy LaBombard and the late Mick LaBombard of Cohoes, N.Y. Michael was educated in Cohoes and graduated from Catholic Central High School. A proud veteran that served his country as a Sergeant in the U.S. Army (Air Defense, Communication and Medical) from 1977-1988, stationed in West Germany for part of his military career. After his service in the U.S. Army he returned home to the Capital District where he was employed at CDTA, Pepsi and NYS DOT.
