“ **PATRICIA LAMB - APOSTLE OF THE RESURRECTION**  
**BORN IN COHOES, N.Y.: MAY 14, 1946 AGE: 73**  
**DIED IN ALBANY, N.Y.: JULY 15, 2019 APOSTLE:**  
**26 years**

*Who was this Christian woman who, as she herself wrote “I became an Apostle as a result of a need for ‘timeout’ to refocus on spiritual goals”?*

*From her young years, she was a member of St. Bernard’s Church in Cohoes, New York. She completed her elementary school at St. Bernard’s Academy, and then attended high school at Keveny Academy in Cohoes. She went on for further studies and was a proud alumna from Nazareth College in Rochester, New York where she specialized in Art Education. In time, she also was a qualified Realtor. For many years she had been employed by the State of New York in their Department of Tax and Finance. Pat was a well-rounded individual, who responsibly fulfilled responsibilities in the “work world”, but cared for her aging parents with loving and untiring dedication. In her obituary it was noted that “she was an elegant and refined person with a love of the theater and the arts”, and enjoyed her hobbies of needlework and reading.*

*Patricia later became a member of St. Michal’s Parish in Cohoes and was involved in many parish activities. It was when she served as the President of the Rosary Society, that she was invited to become an Apostles of the Resurrection. “She felt that the structure of the organization and the support of its membership, as well as the philosophy and charism of the Sisters of the Resurrection gives its members the opportunity for spiritual guidance in a relaxed atmosphere.” She felt drawn to the Foundresses – Mother Celine and Mother Hedwig – admiring their strong sense of family; that they were women who saw a sense of purpose in their frustrations and yet persevered to accomplish their set goals. These facts resonated with her own experience at the time, in the face of the suffering she was undergoing caused by negative criticisms. Their example helped her to rise above her pain and to hold no grudges. Though Pat was unable to attend the monthly meetings due at first*

*to family commitments and then to her own failing health, she remained faithful to her commitment to the Risen Jesus. She entered into the joy of the Risen Jesus very peacefully.*
