Patrick W. McCann, 75, passed away peacefully on January 15th. Born in Philadelphia, he was the son of the late Patrick and Ruth McCann. Husband of Mery Alvarado, and a veteran of Vietnam, serving in the Marine Corps, and was awarded 4 Purple Hearts

Patrick owned and operated Pat's Steaks in Philadelphia from 1984 to 1994. He also owned his own home remodeling company.

While a resident at the Eddy Village Green, Patrick was active in the community, making calls to other Veterans and supporting local charities. One time, Patrick was touched by a news story about a Girl Scout hoping to sell the most cookies in the capital district area. Patrick purchased well over 200 boxes to help her reach her goal.

Patrick always made time for fellow veterans on campus, and he had great reverence for service members. Patrick purchased an engraved memorial stone at the fountain, in memory of an elder on campus. He would not miss a birthday. Patrick sent flowers to other residents, sometimes staff members and strangers. Patrick would read the newspaper and when he discovered that a veteran passed away, he sent flowers to the family. He was very generous

and cared about others.

There are no calling hours, and funeral services will be private. Interment will be held at the Arlington National Cemetery.
