



## Paul J. Benoit

August 25, 1929 - February 23, 2024

Paul J. Benoit, 94 after a brief illness, died peacefully with his family by his side on Friday, February 23, 2024 at Albany Medical Center. Born in Sheldon, VT, son of the late Amede and Amelia Fournier Benoit, he resided in Cohoes most of his life.

Paul proudly served his county in the US Army during the Korean War as Private First Class in the 77th infantry division. He was employed for many years by the Painter's Union Local 201 and later by the Parks and Recreation for the City of Cohoes.

In 1954 Paul married the love of his life, Joan, together they raised four children. He loved to go bowling on his weekly family league, bet on the horses at Saratoga in the summers, attend the county fairs, apple picking in the fall, and travel whether it was to the beach or to Walt Disney World.
