



## Robert J. Hebert

June 9, 1941 - September 7, 2025

Robert “Bob” J. Hebert, 84, of Easton, New York, passed away peacefully on Sunday evening, September 7, 2025, at St. Peter’s Hospital after a long illness.

Born on June 9, 1941, in Cohoes, Bob moved to Troy with his family following the death of his father when he was 14. He graduated from Troy High School with the Class of 1960.

Soon after graduation, Bob proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1960 to 1963 as a dispersing clerk with Patrol Squadron Forty-Nine (VP-49). In November 1965, he began his career with the New York State Police, first serving at the Leeds station in Catskill before transferring to SP Salem (now Greenwich) in Troop G. He later became sergeant and station commander at SP South Glens Falls, and ultimately concluded a distinguished 36-year career in 2001 as the Emergency Management NCO at Troop G Headquarters in Loudonville, NY.

Following retirement, Bob continued his service to his community and state as an Emergency Management Coordinator with the Federal Emergency Management Agency. In his later years, he found great joy in traveling with his wife, Pat, especially during their regular visits to Mexico, where they were often joined by their children and grandchildren.

Bob and his beloved wife, Patricia Ann Hebert, shared 61 years of marriage, and he passed away on the very day of their anniversary. He was predeceased by his parents, Wilfred and Leona Hebert; his brothers, Wilfred, Earl, and Francis; nieces Debra, Wendy, and Sherry; and nephew Mark.

He is survived by his children, Robert "BJ" Hebert of Johns Creek, GA, and Tracy (Harold) Snell of Easton, NY; his grandchildren Mason and Carter Hebert, Noah (Tamra Boldt) Hebert, Ian (Desiree) Snell, and Ryan (Tai) Snell; and six great-grandchildren: Audrey, Harold, Lane, Salem, Jaxon, and Jace.

Funeral services will be held Saturday September 20, 2025 at 11am from Transfiguration Parish, 17 South Main Street Schaghticoke NY 12154.
